Visitors will enjoy cookies with spiced cider or spiked cider for the grown-ups. The

evening train ride includes light-up reindeer antlers for children to wear on the Reindeer Railway to help light the way for Santa.

All activities and events are designed for a safe and fun visit so families can focus on the joy of the season. Special events are offered through January 3<sup>rd</sup>, including Bmore Local Holiday Bazaar, evening train rides on the Reindeer Railway with Holiday Lights, Tea with Mrs. Claus and Toddler Time with Santa.
